1. What is your favorite kind of music and why?

Let's Dig

1. What is one thing Pastor Dale said that you want to discuss?
2. Read Matthew 12:35. Do you agree with the message of this verse? Why or why not? Have you seen this in your own life?
3. During this past week what have your words revealed about the condition of your heart?
4. We can allow feelings to run our life or make choices to run our life. Which do you tend to do and what is the result? Are you happy with the way you are living in this area?
5. Read Romans 12:18. What does this tell us about difficult relationships and our responsibility?
6. Read Ephesians 4:29. What is to be the purpose of our words? What helps you speak in this way? What makes it more difficult?
7. Read John 4:1-26. What comments do you have about this interaction Jesus had with a Samaritan woman?
8. Principles for reconciliation: Choose to become the reconciler, Be prepared to go out of your way, Wait for the right opportunity, Go first and be vulnerable, and Offer hope. How can you apply these in your life this week?
9. Identify whoever you need to be reconciled with and pray for God to give you the courage and the compassion to take specific steps to be a reconciler.

Let's Act

1. If you know of a person in your life that you need to be reconciled with, do what is needed to intentionally begin that journey. Then share stories at your next meeting.
