### Let's Review

- Spiritual gifts generally fall into three categories: Service, Speaking, and Signifying ([see next page for specifics](#)).
- God still does miraculous works through His servants.
- We are all miracle workers when we use Spirit given gifts to accomplish Christ's continued presence on earth—even in seemingly mundane or "normal" expressions.

- Read 2 Timothy 3:1-17 and talk about training your spirit.
  - a. What role does God's Word play in our training?
  - b. Why must we train?
  - c. How does persecution factor into the author's call for training?
- Read John 4:43-53, 14:9-12, 20:24-31 and talk about miracles.
  - a. What is a miracle?
  - b. What is the purpose of miracles?
  - c. How do we reconcile what Jesus says in 4:48 and what is written in 20:30-31?
- Read James 1:16-22 and talk about faith in action.
  - a. How do the author's commands fit with your spiritual gifts?
  - b. Thinking metaphorically, how should "looking in the mirror" motivate us?
  - c. Why is action so important for our faith, our fruit, and our gifts?

### Let's Act

- Let your spiritual gifts help you bear the fruit of the Spirit. Each day, focus on one fruit and one spiritual gift that may produce that fruit (following the example Dale suggested in his sermon). Pay attention to how this impacts your day. Follow up with each other as a group next week to see how everyone is doing on this.

## **Division of Spiritual Gifts:**

- Service Gifts:
  - Mercy (gifted ability to sympathize with the suffering)
  - Service (gifted joyful service behind scenes)
  - Hospitality (gifted desire to offer your home to others)
  - Giving (gifted financial ability to give above and beyond)
  - Administration (gifted ability to orchestrate details)
  - Leadership (gifted ability to govern wisely)
  - Faith (gifted vision to see what is not there yet)
  - Discernment (gifted ability to detect error)
  
- Speaking Gifts:
  - Knowledge (gifted ability to search and acquire biblical truth)
  - Wisdom (gifted insight and application of truth)
  - Preaching (gifted ability to rightly proclaim God's truth)
  - Teaching (gifted ability to explain God's truth)
  - Evangelism (gifted ability to clearly present the gospel to unbelievers)
  - Apostleship (gifted ability to start new works)
  - Shepherding (gifted ability to care for the church)
  - Encouragement (gifted ability to inspire, encourage and comfort)
  
- Signifying Gifts:
  - Tongues (gifted ability to speak in a foreign (known or unknown language).
  - Interpretation of tongues: (gifted ability to interpret the language spoken in a tongue).
  - Miracles (Spiritual ability to actuate the supernatural intervention of God in ways that violate the natural order of things).
