Let's Talk

- How have you been doing on using your spiritual gifts to bear fruit?

Let's Review

- 96% of unchurched people are somewhat likely to attend church... if they are invited!
- As believers, we have a hard time inviting the unchurched to church because we misunderstand what evangelism is and/or we've lost touch with the unchurched
- You have an OIKOS, an extended household, which includes unchurched people
- Three "nots" that open the doors for church invitation: I'm not from here, things are not going well, and I was not prepared for this.

Let's Dig

- How and why did you become a Christian?
- Do you find it difficult to talk with unchurched people about your faith? Why or why not?
- Where are the unchurched people in your OIKOS? (Family, neighbors, coworkers, etc.)
- How important is it to have unchurched people in your OIKOS?
- Read Luke 10:25-37 and talk about being a good neighbor.
 - a. Why is the love of neighbors included next to our love of God?
 - b. What is the significance of a Samaritan helping a Jew?
 - c. Who are your neighbors? What would it look like for you to "go and do likewise?"
 - d. Who saw the hurt man: the priest, the Levite, or the Samaritan? What does this tell you about truly *seeing* another person?
- Read Matthew 28:16-20 and talk about telling others about Christ.
 - a. Where is our mission field?
 - b. How is verse 18 connected logically to verses 19 & 20?
 - i. What does this tell you about why we tell others about Christ?
 - c. What are all the components of this great commission?
- Read 1 Peter 3:13-17 and talk about reasons for hope.
 - a. What is your reason for the hope that you have in Christ?
 - b. Why is it important to have reasons for faith?
 - c. What does suffering for doing good have to do with having reasons for faith?

Let's Act

- Pray for, serve, or share your faith with at least one person on your Adopt 7 list this week. Talk about how things went next time in your LifeGroup. Be sure to celebrate any ways that God moved through your group doing this.
