Series: Respect What?

Scripture: Exodus 20:7

Date: April 16 & 17, 2016

—[LET'S TALK]—

- Have you ever had a nickname? Did/do you like it or dislike it? How did you get it?

—[LET'S WARM UP]—

- Why do people say "OMG!" or "Jesus Christ!" What emotions may be in play?
- What do you think are the best ways to handle those kinds of emotions?
- Are people's names important? Why or why not?
- What do you hope comes to mind when someone hears your name?

—[LET'S DIG | CHOOSE 1]—

- Read Luke 6:43-48 and talk about actions, words, and God's name.
 1. What do our words and actions reveal?
 2. How are our hearts and words connected with misusing God's name?
 3. What does Jesus imply about His name in verse 46? Why does He ask this question?
 4. How do the things we store up in our hearts impact our words and our future?
- Read Exodus 3:9-15 and talk about God's character and identity.
 1. Why would Moses ask for God's name? What importance does a name hold?
 2. How does God answer Moses? What is the significance of "I AM?"
 3. Considering verse 11, how might it impact Moses to know that God "IS?" What significance does it have for us today?
 4. Why might God give the Israelites His personal name (Yahweh, or "The LORD")?

—[LET'S ACT]—
