**The God Who Can Be Known:
Friendship With God**

Scripture: 1 John 1:1-2:2

Date: October 21 & 22, 2017

—[LET'S START]—

- Pastor Dale opened with the time he was at the table with a well-known author/speaker. Who are some folks, living or dead, with whom you would like to "sit at the table?" What would you want to ask them?

—[LET'S TALK]—

1. Have a person or two read the passage (1 John 1:1-2:2). In the opening two verses, there are two distinct phrases which describe Jesus from this passage (Word of Life and Eternal Life). What goes through your mind when you hear Jesus described in this manner?
2. Pastor Dale spoke about Luke 7 (see verses 18-23) when John the Baptist (not John the Apostle) sent messengers to ask Jesus a question: "Are you the One Who is to come or should we expect someone else?" John the Baptist had proclaimed Jesus to be the One, the Messiah. Why do you think he is asking the question? Have you ever faced a difficult circumstance and wondered if Jesus is real, is Who He said He was? What was Jesus' response to John the Baptist?
3. John the Apostle writes about "walking in the light." What does walking in the light look like in a person's life, in your life?
