In addition to 19 years as senior pastor of Wooddale Church, **Rev. Peter Unruh** has pastored four other churches and is presently in his 14th year with an inter-denominational evangelical church in San Jose, CA. The membership of this congregation represents over 25 denominations. Peter has been a police and hospital chaplain for 15 years and served on the board of the National Association of Evangelicals for 12 years. During an eight-year period on the board of World Relief he traveled to various countries including Africa, Korea and Vietnam during the war. Peter is a graduate of Augsburg College and Bethel Seminary and received degrees in Music and Sociology as well as a master's degree in Theology.

Leith Anderson is Pastor Emeritus of Wooddale Church where he was senior pastor for 35 years from 1977 through 2011. He is the president of the National Association of Evangelicals (NAE), holding this office from 2001 to 2002 and again from 2006 to the present. Leith Anderson speaks frequently at conferences, has traveled to all seven continents and has been interviewed and widely quoted by national publications and broadcasts. He is a graduate of the Moody Bible Institute of Chicago; Bradley University, Peoria, Illinois (BA in Sociology); Denver Seminary, Denver, Colorado (Master of Divinity); Fuller Theological Seminary, Pasadena, California (Doctor of Ministry); and holds honorary doctorates from Cornerstone University, Eastern University and the Moody Bible Institute.

Senior Pastor Dale Hummel was born to missionary parents and spent his childhood among the primitive people of Papua New Guinea. He has served as senior pastor of Wooddale Church for the past five years and regularly visits training centers throughout Asia and Africa to teach pastoral leadership. He received his Bachelor of Arts degree in Bible and Theology from St. Paul Bible College (now Crown College) in the Twin Cities, his Master of Divinity from Ashland Theological Seminary and his Doctor of Ministry degree from Trinity Theological Seminary in Newburgh, Indiana.
