Icebreaker

Who is a celebrity you idolize? Why?

Discussion

- Who is one person in your life that you look up to who is... In your family? Older than you? At school?
- What's one positive thing about looking up to someone?
- What's one negative thing that can happen when we look up to someone else?
- What's one thing that might make a student feel like they're not good enough?
- How might knowing God says we're good enough change the way we see ourselves?
- How does it feel to know that God loves you just the way you are?
- What's one step you can take toward changing the way you see yourself?
- How has God uniquely created you to bless others? (serving, teaching, encouraging, giving, leading, being kind, etc.)
- Who is one person God is calling you to bless this week?

Activity

Have your students brainstorm a few negative thoughts they have about themselves along with new, positive thoughts that can replace their old ones. Model how to do this by giving them an example from your own life!
