Icebreaker

What was something that you tried to learn as a kid that you thought you'd be GREAT at right away, but turns out it was tougher than you thought?

Discussion

1. How does it feel when you try something new and you aren't good at it? Frustrated? Mad? Sad? Why do you feel that way?
2. Do you fall into the category of feeling like you aren't doing enough to be enough? Or you did something and now you don't feel like you are enough?
3. How can you relate to Zaccheus and his story? Do you think you have a certain reputation? Maybe you feel like you aren't good enough for Jesus or for others? Maybe you feel shocked Jesus would choose you and make it personal with you?
4. Take a moment to think about something that you feel is separating you with God. If you feel comfortable, share that with a small group leader or someone you trust. Pray and ask God to help remove that barrier between you and Him.
5. What's one thing you can do this week to live knowing that Jesus loves you no matter what?
